p.330 The new strafers - in order of appearance, these were the Douglas A-20, the Bristol Beaufighter, and the B-25 strafers; work on developing the latter was underway by June, and was initiated under Brett's command, not Kenney's – Gunn, *Pappy Gunn*, p.138.
